## New Features

As of v2.7.0.2.0, Oracle Utilities Analytics dashboards will be provisioned in Oracle Analytics Server (OAS) in place of Oracle Business Intelligence Enterprise Edition (OBIEE).

## Enhanced Products

This section describes the products enhanced in Oracle Utilities Analytics v2.7.0.2.0.

### Oracle Utilities Outage Analytics

As of v2.7.0.2.0, Oracle Utilities Extractors and Schema for Oracle Utilities Network Management System have been enhanced to include the Control Zone information as one of the primary key columns for the Storm Dimension. The Storm dimension now also stores the information for the control zones at which the storms occurred. All the facts referring the Storm dimension have now been made to refer using the Control Zone information as well in addition to the Storm information.

## Demo Data Information

The Oracle Utilities Analytics v2.7.0.2.0 demo database contains sample data based on the application versions provided with this release.

Demo data provides sample configuration and data for key application features. It is delivered as part of the base installation. Refer to the *Oracle Utilities Analytics Installation Guide* for more information or contact My Oracle Support.

Oracle recommends that you do not clone the demonstration environment as a basis for a new production environment. The demonstration environment typically includes transactional data that will be irrelevant to your production environment and can cause unexpected issues if it is not purged correctly. The recommended process is to start a new production environment from a new installation and migrate “clean” system data (such as business objects and algorithms) and administrative data from the demonstration and/or test or development environments as applicable.

## Known Issues
