1. Release Notes

1.1 Background

Oracle Financial Services Software Limited has developed Oracle FLEXCUBE Universal Banking, which enable banks to create a distributed network of branches for effective marketing and efficient handling of customer transactions.

1.2 Purpose

The purpose of this Release Note is to propagate the enhancements in Oracle FLEXCUBE Universal Banking 14.5.2.0.0.

A patch release is an official Oracle patch release for Oracle FLEXCUBE Universal Banking. The fourth & fifth digit in a patch release string indicates the patch release number. The first three digits indicate the release to which the patch is applied. For example, release 14.5.1.0.0 is the first patch for Release 14.5.0.0.0 each patch release includes libraries and files that have been rebuilt to implement one or more fixes. Each patch release is incremental. In other words, the latest patch release includes new fixes released after last patch released for the same release.

1.3 **Patch Requirements**

Customers installing this release should refer to 14.5_Patchset_Deployment_Guidelines.docx and 14.5.2.0.0 Java Services Deployment Guidelines.docx included in the Patch Release zip file. Confirm this patch release applied after applications of previous patch releases up to 14.5.1.0.0 completed successfully.

1.5.1 Phase 1 Common core entities replication to OBMA core

Following entities are replication feature is added from ODT core to OBMA core for DB part.

- Currency definition

- > Rate type

Replication request will get logged whenever these above entities authorized in common core. The replication request will be logged based on parameter maintained.

1.5.2 Zero Downtime Patch Set Installation Installer Changes

- Patch set Installation with Zero downtime (ZDT) requires Installer to use editions in a Database Schema.
- Installer is enhanced to use Database Schema Editions and apply DB compilation in patch set edition and then Base edition in a staggered manner to achieve Zero Downtime during the Patch set Installation.
- JDBC connections through Application, Gateway, and ATM etc. to point to a specific edition (Patch set edition or Base edition) at appropriate stages are brought in.
