2. Prerequisite

The patchset package will contain one or multiple zip files. Before proceeding with installation, you have to unzip them into the same common folder.



3. Installation

Installation procedure is classified in the following two scenarios:

- 1. Already on the base release
- 2. Fresh / New Installation

3.1 Already on the base release

- Undeploy all the wars.
- Refer the Annexure section below and update domain-config-deploy.env files.
- Restart all Managed Servers.
- Deploy wars from the above patchset folder.

3.2 Fresh / New Installation

- Patchset Oracle Banking Virtual Account Management 14.5.4.0.0 should be directly deployed, without having to deploy the base release.
- Follow the Oracle Banking Virtual Account Management Installation guide on OTN and deploy the patchset
- Refer the Annexure section below and update domain-config-deploy.env files.

Initial setup

- Run the following files in their respective schemas:
 - cmc_initial_setup.sql (Common core schema)
 - sms_initial_setup.sql (SMS schema)
 - plato_sec_me_admin_user_creation.sql (Plato Security schema)



4. Annexure

4.1 domain-config-deploy.env

The properties mentioned in the below table have fixed values and should not be changed unless suggested. For the complete properties of domain-config-deploy.env file, refer to the folder /pre_deployment_setup under OSDC zip.

Note: Property *flywayTask* value <u>must be</u> updated to *repairMigrate* for OBVAM Domain only for incremental deployment.
