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1. Configuring EDGE

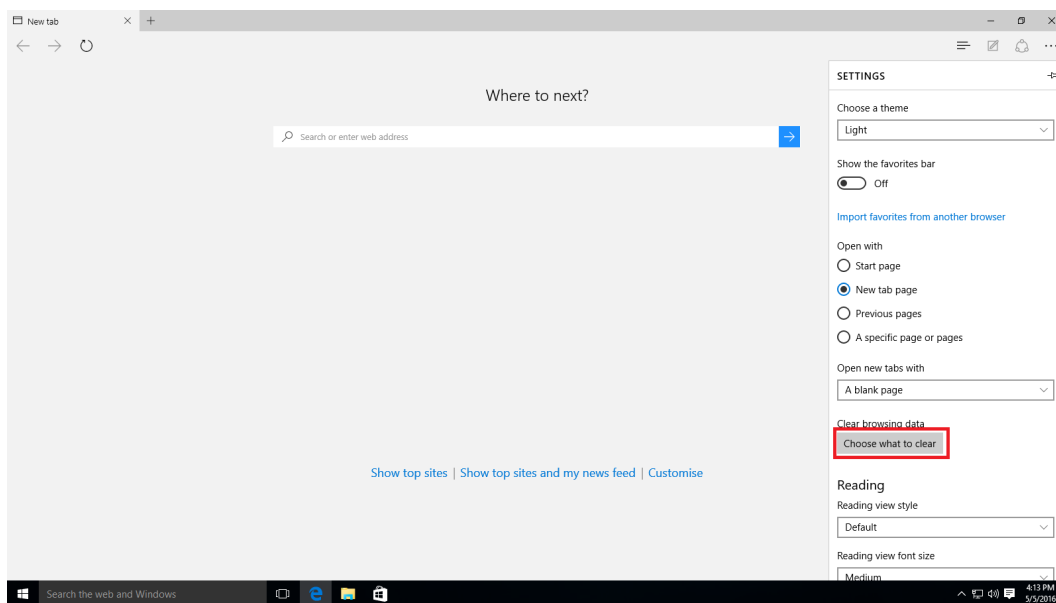

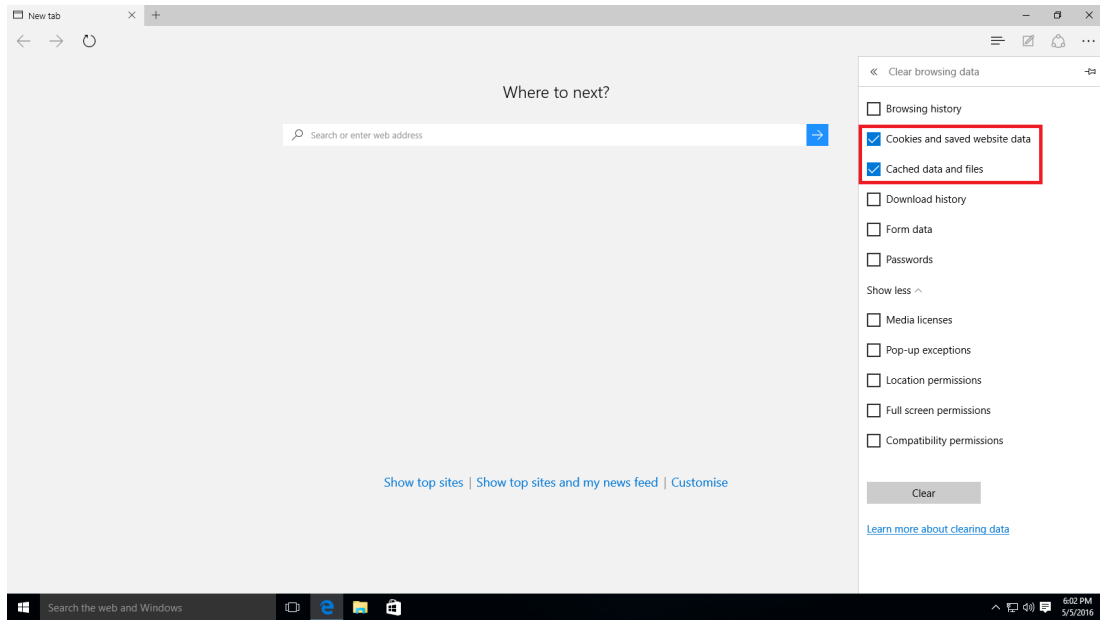
1.1 Clearing Cache

To clear cache, follow the steps given below:

1. Open EDGE and in Settings, click on Choose what to clear.



2. Check the highlighted options and press clear.



1.2 Launching the URL

While launching the URL specify /LoginServlet along with the URL provided. If the URL already has /LoginServlet, then no need to specify.

E.g.: the URL specified should be in the format

<ip address>:<port>/<application context>/LoginServlet



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
