1. Configuring Internet Explorer

Oracle Banking Trade Finance does not support Microsoft Internet Explorer Beta, Partner Build or a Release Candidate. It must be the Final build of Microsoft Internet Explorer. You can view the version information from the Help menu of Internet Explorer. Select 'About Internet Explorer' from the Help menu.



1.1 Configuring Internet Options

In order to run Oracle Banking Trade Finance, you need to configure the internet options as follows:

1. Start Internet Explorer. Go to Tools > Internet Options. The 'Internet Options' screen is displayed.

- 6. Once these settings are done, go to 'Advanced' tab and check the box 'Use JRE (Version) for appletscore.com (requires restart)'.



1.2 <u>Creating Shortcut for Oracle Banking Trade Finance Applica-</u> tion Browser with –nomerge Parameter

To create shortcut for Oracle Banking Trade Finance application browser, follow the steps given below:

1. Right click on Desktop, mouse over 'New' and select 'Shortcut'.

In this case C:\Program Files\Internet Explorer\iexplore.exe is the location of Internet Explorer.
