2.2 Maintenance for Oracle Banking Origination

To maintain Oracle Banking Routing Hub configuration in common core for Bureau Integration Service.


Prerequisite

Specify User Id and Password, and login to Oracle Banking Origination Home screen.

To import the services:

- 1. From Home screen, click Core Maintenance. Under Core Maintenance, click Routing Hub.
- 2. Under Routing Hub, click RPM_ORIGINATION.

4. Under RPM_ORIGINATION, click CBS.


Figure 2: RPM Origination






5. Click Edit.

Figure 3: RPM Origination




6. Change the host and port as per the Bureau Integration Service installation and save it.

7. From RPM_ORIGINATION screen and click Consumer Service.


Figure 5: Consumer Services
