### 2.1 Execution Order of Installation Manual

Oracle Banking Supply Chain Finance installation is executed in the below sequence:

- Oracle Banking Microservices Platform Foundation Installation Guide
- Security Management System Service Installation Guide
- Common Core Services Installation Guide
- Oracle Banking Supply Chain Finance Services Installation Guide
- Oracle Banking Supply Chain Finance User Interface Installation Guide

- OBSCF\_{release number}\_Part5.zip
