# 2 Oracle Financial Services Regulatory Reporting For Bank of England

Oracle Financial Services Regulatory Reporting For Bank of England (OFS REG REP BOE) enables banks to automate risk reporting to central banks and regulators in a single integrated environment. It automates end-to-end processes from data capture through submission with industry-leading solutions, eliminating the need for further manual intervention. It is a standalone product that has pre-built integration with Regnology's Solution for Regulatory Reporting - AgileREPORTER and has the capability to integrate with any other third-party tools for the end mile reporting forms. The solution ensures data integrity allowing banks to focus more time on analyzing and gaining new business insight from their growing stores of data instead of preparing data and reports with the sole objective of meeting submission deadlines. This is made possible by the following:

- Providing Centralized Data Storage for Risk Data through relevant subject areas of the Financial Services Data Foundation (FSDF).
- Interfacing with a Regulatory Reporting tool Regnology AgileREPORTER to build necessary template reports to meet the regulatory expectations.
- Managing the accuracy of risk reporting through Data Governance Studio (DGS).

OFS Regulatory Reporting For Bank of England (OFS REG REP BOE) offers regulatory reporting solutions for the Financial Institutions (FIs) in the UK. The present scope of the release in v81000 includes 11 EFS reports which have undergone regulatory updates in recent past and mandatory to be submitted by all FIs in the region.

## 2.1 Prerequisites

The following are the prerequisites to install the OFS REG REP BOE application:

- Oracle Financial Services Regulatory Reporting For Bank of England v8.1.2.9.0 should be installed and configured on your machine.
- Install and Configure Oracle Financial Services Analytical Applications Infrastructure (OFSAAI) v8.1.2.5.0 (patch 36420089) and other prerequisite OFSAAI Patches (see Section 4 Pre-installation of OFS AAI Installation and Configuration Guide) on your machine.
- Oracle Financial Services Data Foundation (OFSDF) Application Pack Release v8.1.2.9.0 plus other
  prerequisite OFSDF patches (see <u>OFSDF Application Pack Installation and Configuration Guide</u>
  <u>Release v8.1.2.9.0</u> in the <u>OHC</u> Documentation Library) must be installed and configured on your
  machine.
- Oracle Financial Services AgileREPORTER Release 8.1.2.9.0 AgileREPORTER version 25.4.1-b86.
- Prudential Regulation Authority Template version 22.12.0-b435.

- AgileREPORTER Stats and Regulatory Data Div Template version 3.3.0-b616.
- AgileREPORTER ECR Template version **23.9.0-b122**.
- Ensure that you have executed the .profile file before you trigger the installation.
- Ensure that the FICServer is up and running before you trigger the installation. For information on restarting the services, see the OFS Analytical Applications Infrastructure Release 8.1.2.4.0 Installation and Configuration Guide.

## 2.2 Installing the OFS REG REP BOE 8.1.2.9.1 Release

Perform the following instructions to copy, extract, and install this release:

- 1. Download the archive file from My Oracle Support. Search for the Patch ID **38433658** under the Patches & Updates Tab.
- **2.** Shut down all the OFSAA Services. For more information, see the *Stop Infrastructure Services* section in Oracle Financial Services Advanced Analytical Applications Infrastructure Installation and Configuration Guide.

NOTE

Ensure that the **FICSERVER** is up and running.

- **3.** Execute the chmod -R 750 \$FIC HOME
- **4.** If you have an Unzip utility, skip to the next step.

Download the Unzip utility (OS-specific) unzip\_<os>. I from the location <a href="https://updates.oracle.com/unzips/unzips.html">https://updates.oracle.com/unzips/unzips.html</a> and copy it in **Binary** mode to the directory that is included in your PATH variable, typically **\$HOME** path or directory in which you have copied the 8.1.2.9.1 patch.

Uncompress the unzip installer file using the command:

uncompress unzip\_<os>.Z

NOTE

If you notice an error message "uncompress: not found [No such file or directory]", contact your UNIX administrator.

- 5. Execute the chmod 751 p 38433658 81200 Generic.zip
- 6. Execute the unzip -a <name of the file to be unzipped>
  For example: unzip -a p 38433658\_81200\_Generic.zip
- 7. Execute the chmod 751 OFS REG REP BOE
- **8.** Execute the user .profile
- 9. Navigate to the OFS REG REP BOE/bin directory and execute ./setup.sh SILENT
- **10.** The installation progress can be viewed by periodically refreshing the log file under the OFS\_REG\_REP\_BOE/logs directory.

NOTE

The installation duration may vary between 15mins to 30 mins, depending on the server's performance capabilities.

**11.** After installation is completed, verify the log file for any Errors or Warnings. Contact My Oracle Support in case of any issues.

## 2.2.1 Enabling Adjustment Path

Steps to Execute in Case Regulatory Run Is Not Executed.

- 1. Install BOE 81291.
- 2. The BOE 8129 must already be installed as a pre-requisite.
- 3. Insert the required entity into DIM ORG STRUCTURE.
- 4. Populate Dates Dimension
  - a. Edit the batch <INFODOM> POP DATES DIM and provide start date and end date.
  - b. Execute the batch < INFODOM> POP DATES DIM.
- 5. Edit the batch Fiscal Periods Batch <INFODOM>\_REG\_FISCAL\_PERIODS\_BOE and provide the required parameters depending on the reporting jurisdiction and execute the batch:
  - 'OFS REG REP BOE', 'PRA'  $\rightarrow$  PRA reports
  - 'OFS\_REG\_REP\_BOE', 'EBA'  $\rightarrow$  EBA reports
  - 'OFS REG REP BOE', 'MFSD'  $\rightarrow$  MFSD reports
- 6. In case the above batches are not visible in batch maintenance under operations execute below statement in config schema where <OFSAA LOGIN UID> is the OFSAA user id that will be used to update this batch:
- 7. Update Run Information and populate DIM\_RUN.
  - a. Set F\_REPORTING\_FLAG = 'Y' and V\_RUN\_STATUS = 'Closed'.
- 8. Navigate to FSDF  $\rightarrow$  Unified Analytical Metadata  $\rightarrow$  Business Metadata Management  $\rightarrow$  Save Metadata  $\rightarrow$  Hierarchy.
- 9. Resave the following:
  - FSDF Legal Entity Code for Run HFSDF001
  - FSDF Legal Entity Hierarchy for Run HFSDF003
- 10. Populate FSI\_REG\_LEGAL\_ENTITY\_HIER with:
  - N ULTIMATE PARENT SKEY = Parent entity SKEY
  - N\_LV\_HIERARCHY\_SKEY = (select N\_LV\_HIERARCHY\_SKEY from DIM\_LV\_HIERARCHIES where V\_LV\_HIERARCHY\_NAME = 'Default Org Structure Hierarchy')
- 11. Run Parameters and Mappings

- Populate RUN\_EXE\_PARAMETERS for the run marked with reporting flag Y.
- Populate FCT\_RUN\_LE\_REPORTING\_LE\_MAP for the run and reporting entity.
- Populate **FCT\_REG\_REPORT\_ADJUSTMENTS** for respective cells with run and reporting entity.
- 12. Execute Adjustment DE resave Batch
- Execute the batch <INFODOM>\_RESAVE\_DE\_REG\_COMMON.
- This creates DEADJ001 using FCT\_REG\_REPORT\_ADJUSTMENTS.
- 13. Tasks in AR for Capital\_Plus, LR, MRL001, MRL002 and CAR report.
  - a. Configure the following in AR portal (from kit path /OFS\_REG\_REP\_BOE/bin/external\_deliverables/Config\_Package):

```

b. In RPOWNER schema, execute:



set form_code = 'Capital_Plus'
where form_code like 'CapitalPlus' and template_code =
'CapitalPlusADJ';
```

- c. Restart AR servers.
- d. Create the entity in AR with the same entity code used for adjustments.
- e. Map reports and assign permissions to the entity in AR.
- f. Create and map the calculation engine in AR.
- g. Retrieve the following reports for the MIS date that has adjustment data:
  - PRA → Capital\_Plus, LR, MRL001, MRL002
  - $ECR \rightarrow CAR$
- 14. Task for G01 report. Below tasks are applicable for Capital\_Plus, LR, MRL001, MRL002, CAR as well :
  - a. For CAR only, please execute below delete statement in atomic schema before executing report publish. Rest of the steps are same as mentioned below for G01. The same steps of publish hold good for Capital\_Plus, LR, MRL001, MRL002 reports as well.

DELETE FROM FSI_RR_TEMPLATE_MASTER WHERE V_REG_APP_ID = '
OFS_REG_REP_BOE ' AND V_JURISDICTION_CD = 'EBA' AND V_REPORT_CD = 'CAR'
AND V_TEMPLATE_VERSION IN('V_11', 'V_12')
```

- b. G01 report is available only for adjustment path and is not available in AR. Data can be extracted as a CSV file once published.
- c. Data population steps would be same as above till step 12.

d. Navigate to Regulatory Reports menu under Regulatory Reporting for Bank of England.



e. Click on Report Publish



l. Use Download Reports option to download the CSV extract.



- m. File is exported and placed in server under "ftpshare/ReportExports/EBA/<<PublishID>>" as G01\_<<Entity>>\_<<Publish ID>>.csv
- 15. Publish Reports under Regulatory Reports to publish the retrieved reports of Capital\_Plus, LR, MRL001, MRL002 and CAR report. This publish will allow the reports to be displayed in UI with values and the same can be downloaded as CSV extract. For more details on the publish UI, refer to <a href="#">Oracle Financial Services Regulatory Reporting For Bank of England (OFS REG REP BOE) 8.1.2.0.0 User Guide.</a>

## 2.3 Post-installation Steps

The post-installation steps required for this release are as follows:

- **1.** See the log file in the /OFS\_REG\_REP\_BOE/logs directory to ensure that there are no errors reported. Contact My Oracle Support in case of any issues.
- **2.** In case there is an access error in log as "Object FN\_RR\_CONF\_REG\_METADATA\_COLS is invalid" or "Object FN\_RR\_CONF\_REG\_CELL\_LOGICAL\_MAP is invalid" then execute below grant statements using a SYS user:

```
grant select on <CONFIG USER>.DB_MASTER to <ATOMIC USER>; grant select on <CONFIG USER>.DSNMASTER to <ATOMIC USER>;
```

- **3.** Generate the application EAR or WAR file and redeploy the application on the configured Web Application Server. For more information on generating and deploying the EAR or WAR file, see the *Post Installation Configuration* section in OFS Advanced Analytical Applications Infrastructure Installation and Configuration Guide.
- **4.** Restart all the OFSAA services. For more information, see the *Start Infrastructure Services* section in the OFS Advanced Analytical Applications Infrastructure Installation and Configuration Guide.
- **5.** Resave all hierarchies after executing all the SCDs and before triggering the BOE Run.
