- ▶ Oracle's Java Platform Standard Edition (Java SE) is only for use in running Primavera Analytics.

- ▶ One of the following:
 - ▶ Oracle Database Enterprise Edition
 - ▶ Oracle Database Enterprise Edition with the Partitioning option (Required if more than one supported Primavera database schema is connected to the STAR database or if using Oracle Data Integrator or if certain features for the STAR database are enabled. Refer to the *Primavera Analytics Planning and Sizing Guide* for details.)

For Primavera Analytics with Primavera Unifier Project Controls or Primavera Analytics with Primavera Unifier Facilities and Asset Management, the source Primavera Unifier database must be an Oracle database.

If using Oracle Analytics Server Visual Analyzer features, Oracle Data Visualization is required.

If using Oracle Data Integrator (ODI), Data Integrator Enterprise Edition or Data Integrator Enterprise Edition for Oracle Applications.

Primavera Data Warehouse

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- ▶ Oracle's Java Platform Standard Edition (Java SE) is only for use in running Primavera Data Warehouse.
