1 Overview

2 Known Issues

Due to a known issue in the third-party rich text editor component, the font family detection capability is impacted. A previously saved HTML description, note or email body will show font family as "Default" when editing in the rich text editor. This affects only the detection of the font family - the HTML text is correctly saved and displayed based on the original font attributes. This will be addressed in a future release of the third-party rich text editor component.

Bug 37502276 - NOT ABLE TO DETECT THE FONT FAMILY IN ORTL RTE FOR NEW RECORDS

Due to legacy issues with the Outlook Email Integration (OEI) client users will be unable to use the rich text editor when creating new appointments or tasks in CRM On Demand if "Enable HTML Formatting" is enabled in the company's Profile page. This will be addressed in a future release of the OEI client.
