1 How do I use the Career Roles feature in Opportunity Marketplace?

About Career Roles

Using the Career Roles feature in Opportunity Marketplace, you can browse through career roles that you're interested in. You can see job openings for these roles. You can also see role guides for career roles, which help you understand the requirements defined by the organizational leadership for the role. You can also recommend roles that might be of interest to your peers or reports.

Explore Career Roles in Opportunity Marketplace

Browse through a list of available career roles in Opportunity Marketplace. You'll see job-based career roles, position-based career roles, or both types of career roles.

To do this:

- On the **Explore** tab, select **Career Roles** in the **Opportunity** filter.

Each role card displays:

- The name of the job or position
- The description of the job or position
- Job openings for that job or position

From the **Explore** tab, you can also:

- View your own role using the **View Current Role** button.
- Search for specific career roles. To do this, select the **Career Roles** filter and then search using keywords.

Note: Career roles based on jobs, positions, or both will be displayed depending on the setting of the profile option `ORA_OM_CAREER_ROLE_PROFILE_DISPLAY`.

Role Details Tab

When you select a career role card, the **Role Details** tab displays:

- The career progression path, if it's defined for the role.
- The job description.
- Skills that are defined on the job or position profile. It includes both developed and developing skills.
 - Skills that you already have are listed first with a color-coded indicator, followed by skills that you're yet to achieve. You can also view your skills represented in a spider chart that represents how your current

proficiency on skills matches against the target proficiency defined for those skills on the career role. The chart view displays up to 8 skills at a time. If more than 8 skills are defined for your career role, you can select the skills that you want to see by using the drop-down list. By default, the first 8 skills that have the largest skill gap between the target level and your current proficiency level are displayed. The skills are sorted based on the skill gap in descending order. If you haven't rated yourself on a skill, it's shown at level zero. If a skill doesn't have a target level defined on the job or position profile, it's shown on the chart at level zero.

- Competency map that shows the competency gap.
- Functional competencies such as languages, educational qualifications, accomplishments, and licenses and certifications that are required or good- to-have for the role in their own sections. If you're yet to gain any of these competencies, you'll see an option to add it as a goal to your goal plan. You can also view the descriptive flexfields that are added to qualifications for the role.
- Work requirements such as travel, working hours in the Additional Information section.
- Learning suggestions and career ambassadors to help you bridge the skills and qualifications gaps required for that role. If no learning resources or career ambassadors are available for the role, this section will be empty.

Note: One or more of the above sections might not be displayed if they're not defined in the job profile or position profile for that role.

From this page, you can also set favorites, if you'd like to browse these roles again later. These will be available from the **Favorites** option in the **Opportunity** filter. They will also appear in the **Careers of interest** section in Grow.

View Job Openings for a Career Role

You can view open jobs for a career role of your interest.

1. On the **Explore** tab in Opportunity Marketplace, select **Career Roles** in the **Opportunity** filter.
2. Select a career role card of your interest.
3. Select the **Jobs** tab to view the list of job openings.

Note: When the number of open jobs exceeds 12, you can view the rest of the jobs by selecting the **View all jobs** link. This takes you to the **Explore** tab, from where you can search for jobs. If no jobs are currently available for the role, this tab will be empty.

View Role Guides for a Career Role

You can view role guides associated with a career role, provided role guides are defined and associated with jobs or positions relevant to that career role.

1. On the **Explore** tab in Opportunity Marketplace, select **Career Roles** in the Opportunity filter.

2. Click a card of the career role that you're interested in.
3. On the career details page, select the **Role Guides** tab to view the role guide cards associated with that career. By default, the most recently created role guides are listed on the top row. The role guide card indicates the number of skills that are required for that role guide.

Tip: You can sort the role guides listed based on their name or the date they were updated.

4. Click a role guide card to view these details:
 - Description of the role guide
 - Capabilities for that role guide with these details:
 - Capability description
 - Skills required to attain that capability
 - Tasks to attain the required skills
 - Additional resources to attain the required skills
5. To favorite the role guide, select **Add to Favorites**.

Set Career Preferences

You can set your career preferences and career statement to receive suitable career recommendations in Opportunity Marketplace.

To do this, select **Update Interests** on the **Explore** tab.

To update your work preferences, select **Adjust Preference** in the Career statement and preferences section.

Once you set your preferences, career roles that fit your needs and preferences are recommended. To view the recommendations:

1. Select the **Explore** tab.
2. Select **Recommended** in the **Opportunity** filter.

Recommend Career Roles

You can recommend career roles that might be of interest to your peers from Opportunity Marketplace.

To do this:

1. On the **Explore** tab, select **Career Roles** in the Opportunity filter.
2. Click a career role card that you're interested in.
3. Select **Recommend**.

This action displays a drawer, from where you can select the employees to whom you want to recommend the role. You can optionally provide a reason for the recommendation.

When you recommend a role, it creates a recommendation profile, which you can see on the Recommendation Profiles application. To view this, go to **My Client Groups > Learning and Development > Recommendation Profiles**.

Once the recommendation profile completes running, you can see the career roles displayed on the target employees' Grow page in the **Career role recommendations for you** swim lane on the **Grow Your Career** tab.

The recommendations will also be displayed as part of the **Recommended** filter in Opportunity Marketplace, provided the profile option, ORA_HRD_ENABLE_LLM_SUMM_CAREER_ROLE_SUGGSNS, is enabled.

Note: If the employee has previously added the recommended role to their favorites, the recommendation won't be displayed in Grow.
