Applying Patches for Installing Enterprise Manager Plug-in for Oracle Database Appliance

Download and apply the patches required for installing Enterprise Manager Plug-in for the latest Oracle Database Appliance release.

Note

You must download and install the latest Enterprise Manager Plug-in patches for the plug-in to work with the latest Oracle Database Appliance release.

Steps to download and install the patches required to use the latest Oracle Database Appliance release with Enterprise Manager Plug-in Release 13.5.2.0.0

Download patches 37465968 (OMS), 37465979 (Discovery), and 37465994 (Monitoring) for Oracle Database Appliance Enterprise Manager Plug-in release 13.5.2.0.0 from *My Oracle Support* as follows:

1. Navigate to *My Oracle Support* and search separately for patches 37465968, 37465979, and 37465994.
2. Download all three patch zip files:

```
p37465968_135200_Linux-x86-64.zip  
p37465979_135200_Linux-x86-64.zip  
p37465994_135200_Linux-x86-64.zip
```

3. Unzip the patches and read the README.
4. Follow the instructions in the README and install all three patches.

Error in discovery of Oracle Database Appliance target from Oracle Enterprise Manager 24ai

Failure is reported for Oracle ILOM target during discovery of Oracle Database Appliance from Oracle Enterprise Manager 24ai.

Problem Description

When discovering the Oracle Database Appliance target from Oracle Enterprise Manager 24ai, the Oracle ILOM target is marked as Failed.

This is because the target type `oracle_exa_ilom` is desupported in Oracle Enterprise Manager 24ai.

Failure Message

When you click the Failed link, the following error message may be displayed:

Workaround

The Oracle ILOM target is added as Systems Infrastructure Server target type. Use this target type for Oracle ILOM information.

This issue is tracked with Oracle bug 39337794.
