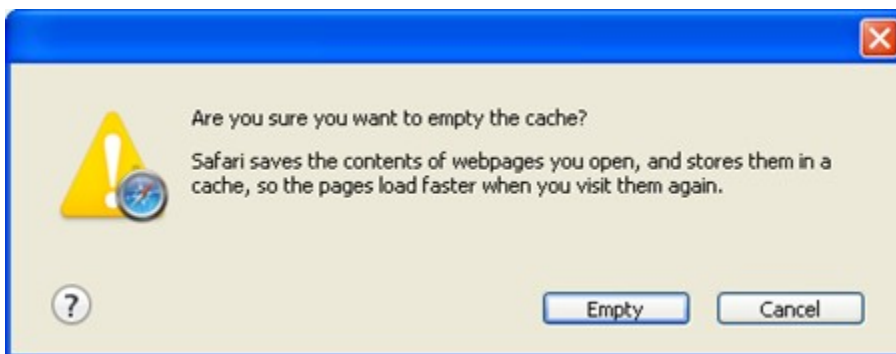

1.1 Clear Cache

1. Start the **Apple Safari** and go to the **Edit** option.
2. Click on the **Empty Cache** option.

A pop-up message displays to confirm the emptying cache.

Figure 1-1 Empty the Cache Message

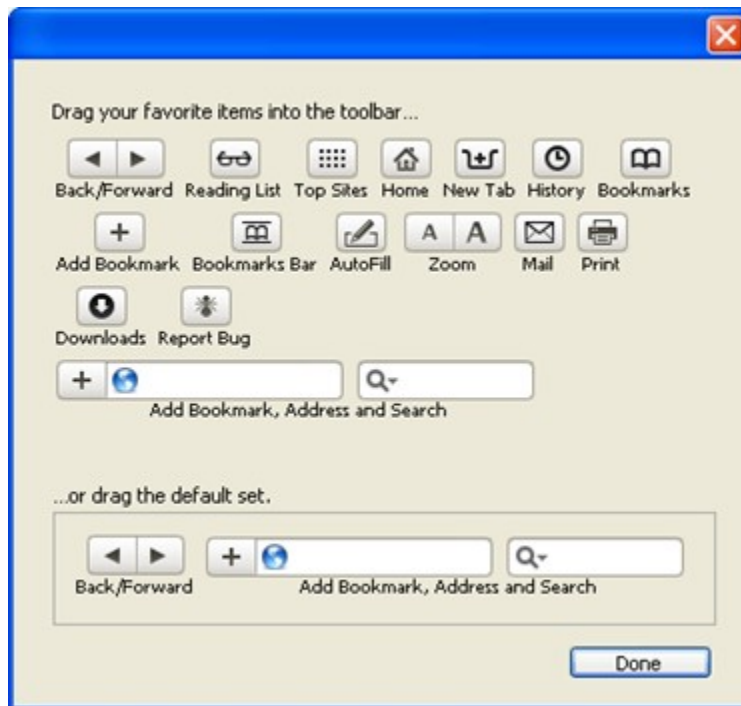


3. Click on the **Empty** button.

1.2 Remove 'Back/Forward' Icon from Toolbar

1. Start the **Apple Safari** and go to the **View** option.
2. Go to the **Customize Toolbar** option.
3. Drag and drop the **Back/Forward** icon from the toolbar to the browser area.

4. Click on the **Done** button.

1.3 Hide Bookmarks Bar, Status Bar and Tab Bar

1. Start the **Apple Safari** and go to the **View** option.
2. Uncheck the **Bookmarks Bar** option to hide bookmarks bar.
3. Uncheck the **Status Bar** option to hide status bar.
4. Uncheck the **Tab Bar** option to hide tab bar.

2.1 Clearing Cache

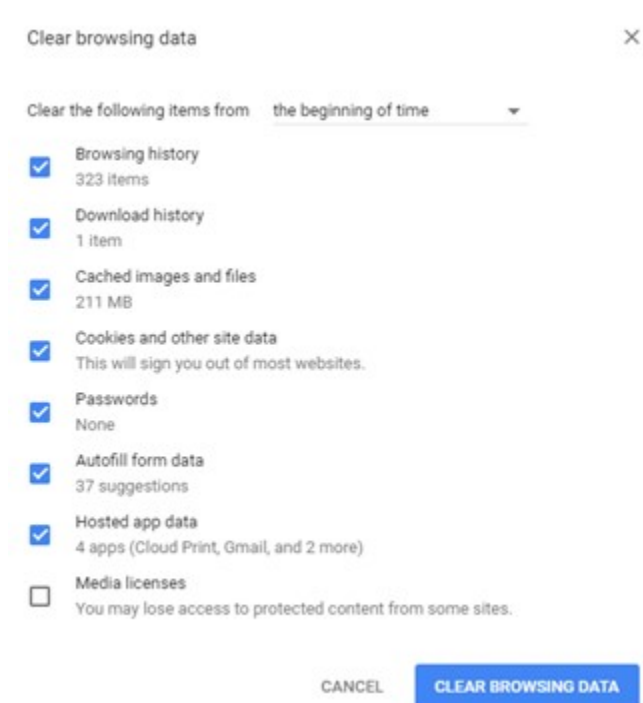
To clear cache, follow the steps given below:

(Optional) Enter task prerequisites here.

1. Start Google Chrome. Click the **Settings** then click **Advanced** and choose **Clear browsing data**.

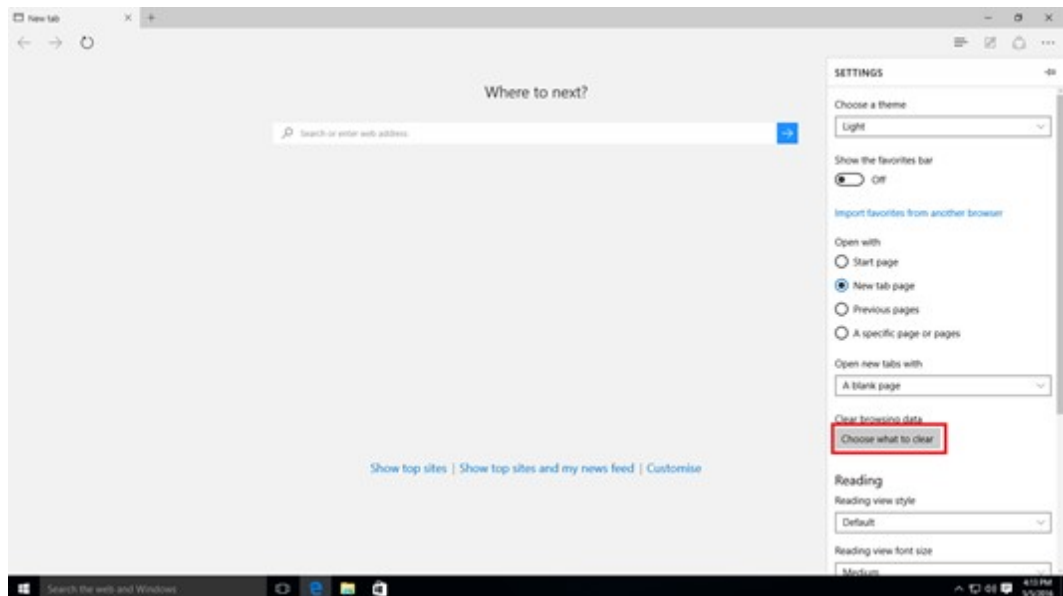

3.1 Clearing Cache

To clear cache, follow the steps given below:

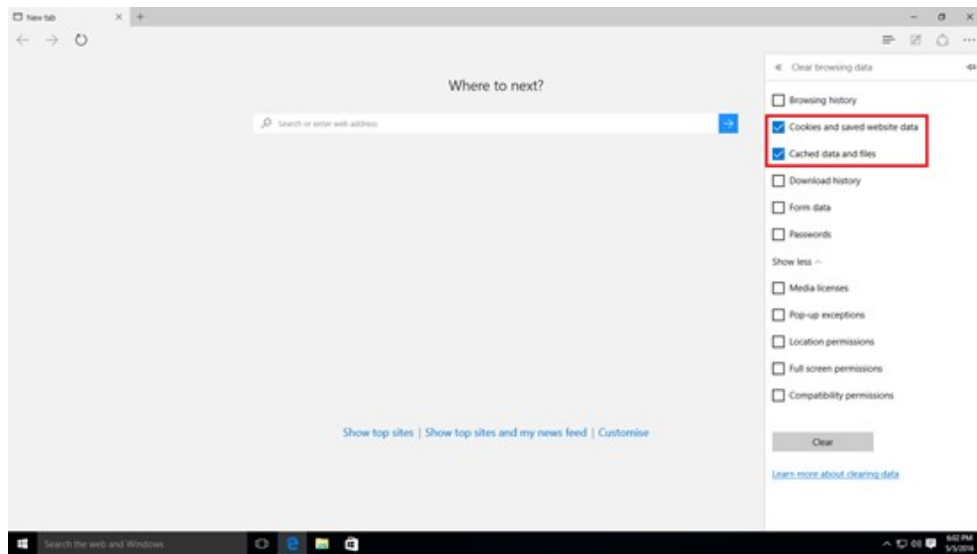
1. Open EDGE and in Settings, click on Choose what to clear.

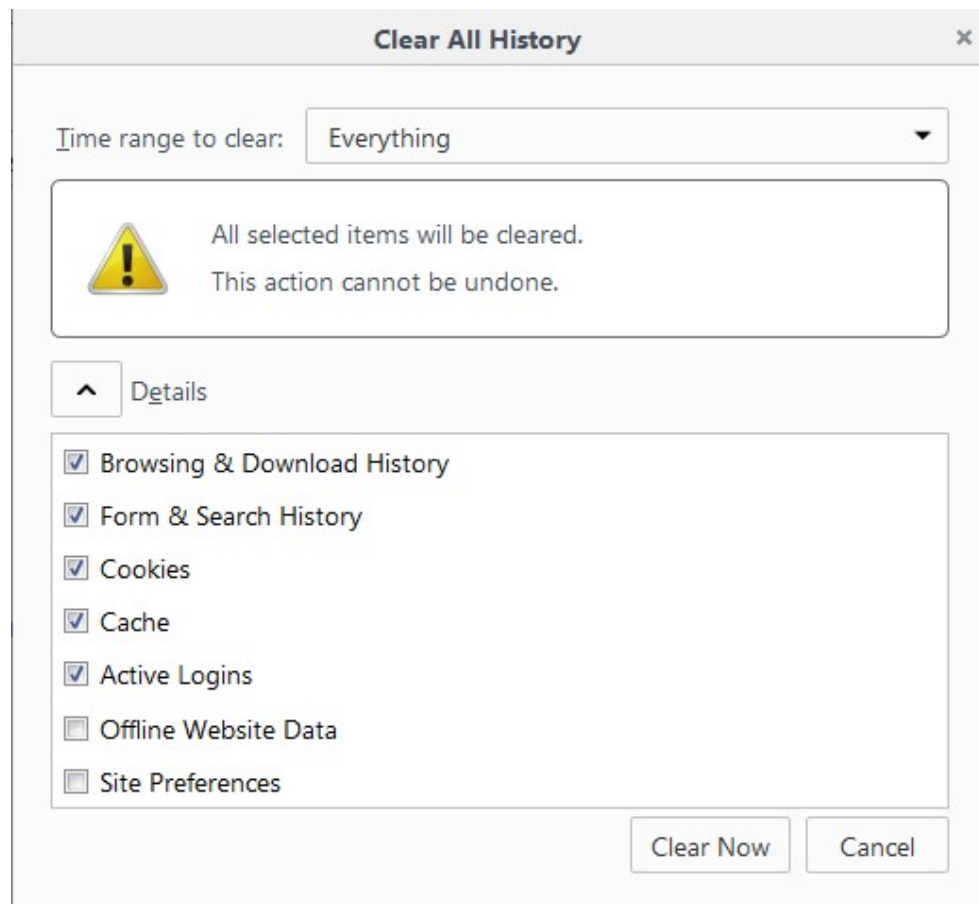

4.1 Clear Cache

1. Start the **Firefox** application.
2. Go to the **Tools** and then click on the **Options**.
3. Click on the **Privacy** option and then click on the **Clear your Recent History**.

Figure 4-1 Clear All History

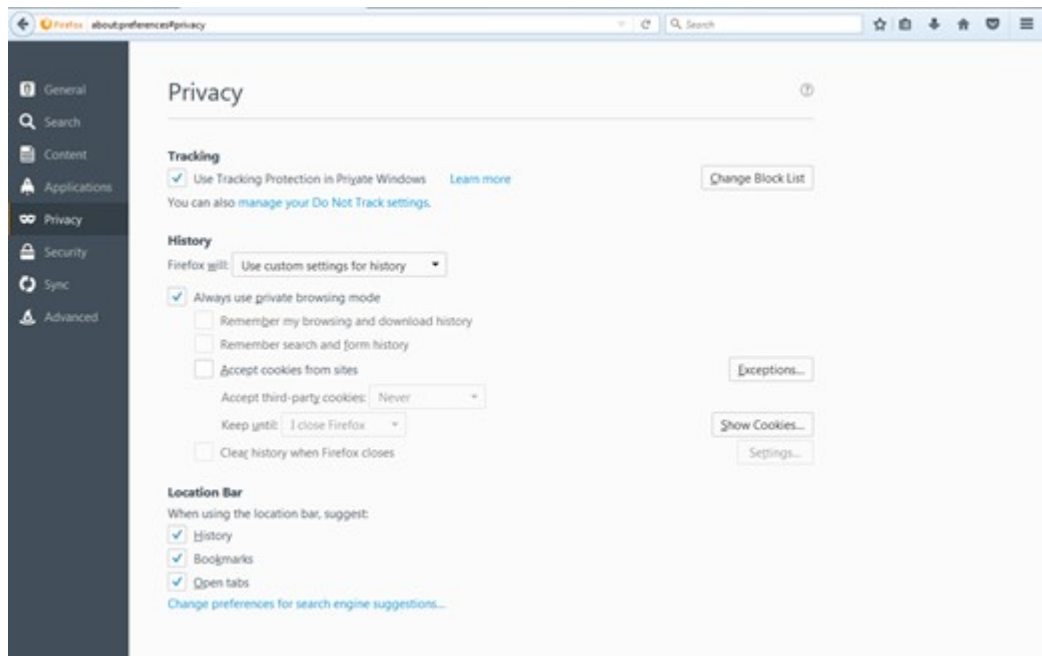


4. Choose **Everything** in the field of **Time range to clear** and then click on the **Clear Now** button.

4.2 Suppress Caching

1. Start the **Firefox** application.
2. Go to the **Tools** and then click on the **Options**.
3. Click on the **Privacy** tab.

Figure 4-2 Privacy

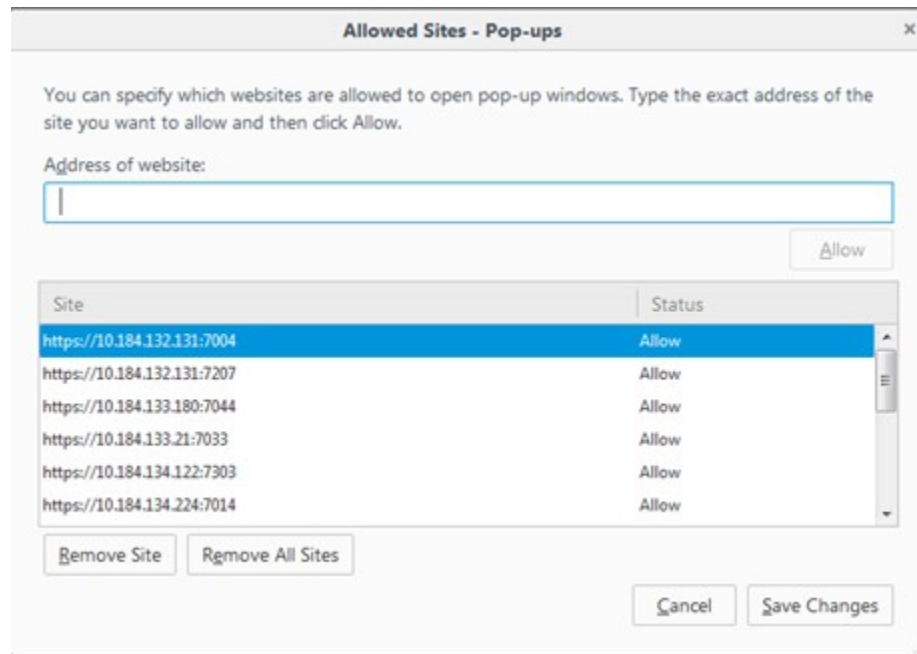


4. Under the **History**, select **Use custom settings for history** option from the drop-down list for the **Firefox will** field.
5. Check the **Automatically start Firefox in a private browsing session** option .
6. Click on the **OK**.

4.3 Enable Pop-ups for Oracle Banking Treasury Management

1. Start the **Firefox** application.
2. Go to the **Tools** and then click on the **Options**.
3. Click on the **Content** tab.
4. Under **Pop-ups**, check the **Block pop-up windows** option and click on the **Exceptions** button.
