This OFS ECM release is cumulative of enhancements and bug fixes since the 8.1.2.10.0 release. It is compatible with the 8.1.2.10.0 release of FCCM Apps.

## Prerequisites

This section lists any required prerequisites for this release.

- Before applying OFS ECM v8.1.2.11.0, it is required to install OFS ECM v8.1.2.0.0. For detailed instructions on installing this OFSECM Release, see [OFS ECM Application Pack Installation Guide 8.1.2.0.0](#).
- Configure the Server Time Zone:  
For ECM standalone installation:
  - The SERVER\_TIMEZONE parameter must be configured in the CONFIGURATION table in CONFIG schema with the correct time zone name.
  - The Date/Timestamps are displayed according to the user's browser time zone.
  - Once the user time zone is saved, the browser date is converted to the Server time zone date and saved in the database.For Pack-on-Pack installation:
  - Update the SERVER\_TIMEZONE parameter in the CONFIGURATION table in CONFIG schema with the following query:  

```
UPDATE CONFIGURATION SET PARAMVALUE='', DESCRIPTION='DB Server Timezone'  
WHERE PARAMNAME='SERVER_TIMEZONE';
```
  - The SYS DB user must provide the following grant to the ATOMIC DB user:  

```
GRANT execute on ctx_ddl to <ATOMIC_USER>;
```

## New Features/Enhancements

The following is the list of new features and enhancements included in OFS Enterprise Case Management Release 8.1.2.11.0:

- **New ECM UI** - Revamped ECM UI offering better experience, removing clutter and optimizing utilization of available screen space.
- **MCC code** - Added Merchant Category Code (MCC) to capture MI, wire and cash transactions.
- **EUR currency format** - Added EUR currency formatting support. For example, 1000.00 EUR is displayed as 1.000,00 EUR.
- **Configurable decimal format** - Added configuration to control the number of decimal places displayed.
- Display both Security ID and Security Name under orders in event details tab
- **Relationship tab enhancement** - Added configuration to determine which parameters to use for establishing relationships between entities for related cases and events.
- **Alert suppression** - Users are able to select a condition for suppressing future events. This can be done while taking decision on a single event and is not possible if user selects multiple events.

**Table 5-1 List of Known Issues**

Bug Number	Description
35526597	Even if a user selects a status other than Closed from the Status drop-down in Advanced Search of the Archived Cases page, only closed cases will be returned in the search results. <b>Workaround:</b> Use only closed status for search.
34789808	In Case Advanced Search, users are able to enter strings in date fields. This should not be allowed. <b>Workaround:</b> Only enter the date values or select the date from the Calendar option.
35854853	The Events of Child table is archived even if the column value of V_CHILD_TABLE_FLAG is set to N. <b>Workaround:</b> Take backup of the FCC_ARC_CHILD_METADATA table, remove the entries, and run the utility.
