OFS Loan Loss Forecasting and Provisioning Application Pack (Language Pack) 8.1.2.0.4 Release

This document describes the necessary steps to install/upgrade and configure 8.1.2.0.4 (Language Pack) and enable the UI of OFS Loan Loss Forecasting and Provisioning Application Pack in different languages in addition to US-English. The Language Pack supported in this release is Japanese.

2.1 Pre Installation Requirements

This document contains detailed information on the pre-installation requirements for the Language Pack

1. Install the OFS Loan Loss Forecasting and Provisioning Application Pack 8.1.2.0.0 before you proceed to the Language Pack Installation. Log in to [My Oracle Support](#) and search for **33813714** under the Patches & Updates Tab. For more information on installing this release, see the [OFS Loan Loss Forecasting and Provisioning Installation Guide](#).
2. Install the OFS AAI Language Pack 8.1.2.0.0. Log in to [My Oracle Support](#) and search for **32791983** under the Patches & Updates Tab.
3. Log in to [My Oracle Support](#) and search for the 8.1.2.0.2 patch **33924158** and the 8.1.2.0.3 patch **35493711** under the Patches & Updates Tab.
4. Perform the following steps to install the patch:
 - a. Download the OFS Loan Loss Forecasting and Provisioning v8.1.2.0.4 archive file from MOS and copy it to your OFSAA server in **Binary Mode**.
 - b. Stop all the OFSAA Services. For more information, see the Start/Stop Infrastructure Services section in the [OFS Loan Loss Forecasting and Provisioning Installation Guide](#).
 - c. If you have the Unzip utility, skip to the next step, or, download the Unzip utility (OS-specific) and copy it in Binary Mode to the directory that is included in your PATH variable, typically \$HOME path or directory in which you have copied the language pack archive file.
 - d. Extract the contents of the OFS Loan Loss Forecasting and Provisioning Application Pack Language Pack 8.1.2.0.4 archive file using the following command:
unzip <name of the file to be unzipped> For example, unzip 35493711_GENERIC.zip
 - e. Grant 755 permissions to the Installation and Download Directory.
 - f. For Silent Mode Installation; navigate to the <directory>/appsLibConfig/conf Path.
 - g. Edit the params.conf File.
 - h. Modify the UPLOAD_MODEL parameter to 0.

- i. Navigate to the <directory>OFS_LLFP/bin Path and execute the command `./setup.sh SILENT`.

2.2 Post Language Pack Installation

To install the contents of this Language Pack, follow these steps:

1. Post successful installation of the Language Pack, perform the configurations as explained in the Post Installation Configuration Section.
2. Delete the existing EAR/WAR file available in the `$FIC_HOME/ficweb` folder.
3. Generate the **EAR/WAR** file and redeploy the application onto your configured Web Application Server. For more information, see the [OFS Loan Loss Forecasting and Provisioning Installation Guide](#) available in the OHC Documentation Library.
4. After the Language Pack has been installed successfully and post-installation configurations are done, restart all the OFSAA Services. For more information, see the [OFS Loan Loss Forecasting and Provisioning Installation Guide](#) available in the OHC Documentation Library.

2.2.1 Report Configuration (OBIEE)

Perform the following steps to configure the reports in OBIEE/OAS for the Japanese Language:

1. Navigate to `$FIC_HOME/LLFP_DASHBOARDS` Directory containing the **LLFP.rpd** File and deploy the RPD. For more information, see the **OBIEE Configuration - Deploy OFS LLFP Analytics** section in the [OFS Loan Loss Forecasting and Provisioning Installation Guide](#).
2. Navigate to `$FIC_HOME/LLFP_DASHBOARDS` Directory containing the **LLFP_ja_JP.catalog** File and deploy the Catalog.
3. Log in to OBIEE/OAS, navigate to the **Administration** Page, select the **Import Caption** option, and then select the Japanese language.
4. Import the following XML files from the `$FIC_HOME/LLFP_DASHBOARDS` folder in the below sequence:
 - a. **ceclcaptions_ja_JP.xml**
 - b. **ifrs+9captions_ja_JP.xml**
 - c. **subledgercaptions_ja_JP.xml**
5. Select **Save** and then log out.
6. Log in to OBIEE/OAS, select the Japanese language and view the translated strings in the Japanese language.
7. Edit the Global Variables.
 - a. In the **Dashboards** drop-down list, click **Disclosure Reports** to open the dashboard.
 - b. Click **Edit** on any of the reports to open the **Settings** Window.
 - c. In the **Criteria** Tab, in the **Selected Columns** Pane, click the **Onerous Classification Code**.

- d. Click **Settings** to open the **Settings** Submenu.
- e. Click **Edit** formula to open the **Edit Column Formula** Window.
- f. In the **Variables** drop-down list, select **Global...** to open the **Insert Global Variable** Window.
- g. Select the Global Variable that you want to edit, and then click **Edit Global Variable**.
- h. Edit a global variable with the following details:**Name** - denomination, **Type** - Text, **Value** - case when '{@denomination}{In Thousand}' = '千' then 1000when '{@denomination}{In Thousand}' = '百万' then 1000000else 1 end. This variable is used to divide all amount values by thousand or million, depending on the selected criteria.
- i. Click **OK**, and then click **OK** again to save.
