### 2.1 New Features

New, changed, and deprecated features of OFS CRR are described, with pointers to additional information.

The following list describes new features and enhancements for OFS CRR Release 8.1.2.10.0:

- ECM Milestone: Updating ECM milestone actions through a web service call. CRR will send feedback on any milestone changes to the ECM audit history. This integration covers all three templates: US SAR, CA-STR, and goAML. Implementing this change as a web service allows ECM investigators to view the current status of a SAR-filed report in real time.
- Configuring Actions using PMF: In CRR, action buttons are managed through Process
  Management Framework (PMF) configurations. Administrators can define which actions
  are available at each workflow stage by adjusting the PMF settings. This dynamic display
  helps streamline the user experience, enforces process compliance, and ensures that
  actions align with organizational policies.
- Multi Template Support: This enhancement allows institutions to configure and manage
  multiple templates—such as CA-STR, goAML, and US SAR—within a single CRR
  instance. The solution ensures that template-specific metadata is maintained separately,
  preventing any overlap or conflicts between templates.

## 2.2 Bugs Fixed in This Release

Bug ID	Description
38351057	goAML – Posted Report: Approve Button Not Visible- It has been observed that, in the goAML module, the "Approve" button is not visible on reports that have already been posted. As a result, users are unable to take further approval actions on these posted reports.
38288965	POP Wallet Setup: goAML Posting Not Working- During the POP Wallet setup, an issue has been identified where the posting to goAML is not functioning as expected
38280716	Multiple Templates Support Not Working as Expected - An issue has been identified where the functionality for supporting multiple templates is not operating as intended. This feature is designed to allow institutions to configure and manage several reporting templates—such as CA-STR, goAML, and US SAR
38233703	ECM Milestones for CA-STR: Duplicate Multiple Entries Issue-It has been observed that the ECM (Enterprise Case Management) milestones for CA-STR (Canadian Suspicious Transaction Report) are showing duplicate or multiple entries for the same milestone event.
38221540	Unable to Save WebConfiguration in RRADMN for POP WebService-There is an issue where users are unable to save the WebConfiguration settings for the POP WebService within the RRADMN (Risk and Reporting Administration) interface.
38186610	SAR Reports Are Not Getting Approved After Applying ECM Milestones - An issue has been identified where Suspicious Activity Reports (SARs) are not moving to an approved state after the application of ECM (Enterprise Case Management) milestones.
38029877	SAR Reports Are Not Getting Approved Properly Due to Package (PKG_RRCA_SAVE) Failure in Data Model During Forward Port from 8128 to 81210 -An issue has been encountered during the forward porting process from version 8128 to
	81210, where the approval of Suspicious Activity Reports (SAR) is failing. The root cause appears to be the failure of the database package PKG_RRCA_SAVE within the data model. As a result, SAR reports are not moving into an approved status as expected after workflow actions are performed.
