39599775	Fixed an issue where documents could not be uploaded from the Document tab.
39497620	Addressed a file path traversal vulnerability identified during a Burp Suite security scan.
39497615	Addressed an SQL injection vulnerability identified during a Burp Suite security scan.

39497056	Fixed an issue where CRR-related files were being removed from the FICHOME layer.
39489887	Fixed an issue where the E-File was downloaded as an empty (0 KB) file.

39427580	Fixed an issue where the GOAML screen became unresponsive when the Approve button was clicked.
39244755	Fixed an issue where the Conductor Details were not saved for posted CASTR reports.
39244516	Addressed an issue where the acknowledgement could not be uploaded for CASTR reports.
39244005	Fixed an issue where signatory details from posted GOAML reports were not reflected in the CRR side after submission.
