This document describes the licensing information for Oracle Jipher.

Product Description

Oracle Jipher is a Java Cryptographic Service Provider (CSP) that wraps a Federal Information Processing Standards (FIPS) 140-3 validated OpenSSL cryptographic module. It enables the deployment of Java applications in FIPS-regulated environments. Jipher makes its cryptographic services available to Java developers using the Java Cryptography Architecture (JCA).

Jipher is offered as part of the [Oracle Java SE Universal Subscription](#) and to Oracle customers running Java workloads in Oracle Cloud Infrastructure (OCI).

This document covers only your entitlement for Oracle Jipher. [Oracle Java SE Universal Subscription](#) also grants you rights to other features. Please review the licensing information user manual for Java SE versions to learn about your rights associated with those Java SE versions.

Prerequisite Products

Jipher 20 requires a current update release of Oracle JDK 17, 21, 25, or 27.
