Oracle Identity Role Intelligence supports User Role Membership Rule. During role mining, the User Role Membership Rule is calculated. The User Role Membership Rule can be modified if required, and can then be exported or published.
- **Support for Managing Outdated Data**
Oracle Identity Role Intelligence, supports management of outdated data. If entities or custom attributes are modified then the data on previous role mining tasks is marked as outdated and the user can remediate or choose to accept.
- **Bug Fixes, Improvements, and Optimizations**
